

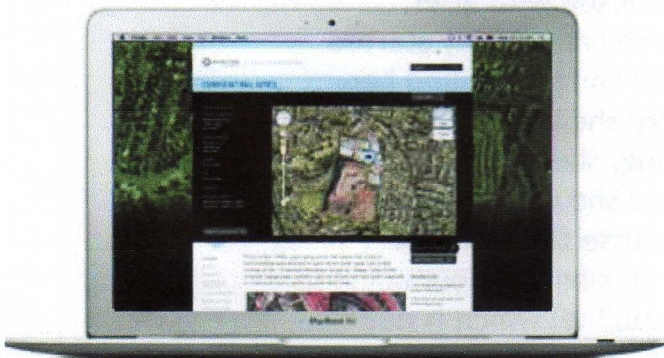
Waterview contract awarded to Fletcher's Well Connected Consortium



The contract to construct Auckland's Waterview Connection has been awarded to Fletcher Concrete and Infrastructure's Well Connected Consortium.

New Zealand's largest construction project since the Harbour Bridge 60 years ago, the Waterview Connection will provide the final link in Auckland's Western Ring Route.

It's anticipated that the \$1.4 billion project — the biggest ever to be undertaken by the New Zealand Transport Agency — will be completed by mid 2017.
